



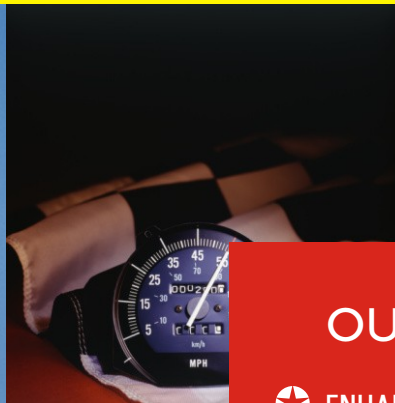

# REMOTE CAR RACING

*Racing remote control cars against other teams. Each team member must drive, work on car maintenance, track design and team communication. Cars are battery powered, clean, safe and environmentally friendly.*

**What actually happens?** *The program consists of 3 parts.*

<b>1 Familiarization &amp; Practice:</b>	First you have to learn how to drive. Some basic rules will be set in place before we give you time to accustom yourself to the controls. Your team also needs to plan your driving roster, who's in the pits, who's out on the track, who's counting the laps, who's letting your team mates know where the other cars are and what laps they are up to.
<b>2 Race Time:</b>	This is how we determine who gets pole position and who starts at the rear of the field.
<b>3 Time Trials:</b>	The race is on, everyone in your team has to drive they must complete a certain number of laps and just like a real race there may be mandatory pits stops and a safety car may even enter the race....
